

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-1659

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING GRATITUDE FOR THE SERVICE OF GAYLA McCULLOCH AS A MEMBER OF THE FARMINGTON CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Gayla McCulloch was elected in March of 2010 to serve on the Farmington City Council on behalf of Council District Three; and

WHEREAS, Councilor McCulloch was re-elected to the City Council in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Councilor McCulloch was appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council in June 2010 to serve on the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, she was appointed by the Mayor in April of 2014 to serve as the Council's *ex officio* member to the City's Board of Public Utility Commissioners (PUC) and has served on the PUC since that time; and

WHEREAS, she was also elected by the Council in 2015 to serve as the Mayor Pro Tem, to serve temporarily as the mayor and conduct the meetings of the City Council in the absence of the elected Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Councilor McCulloch was proactive and responsive to constituent needs; and

WHEREAS, Councilor McCulloch was fully engaged and participated in a number of affirmative votes and offered guidance to improve City infrastructure, including roads; waterlines; sewer lines; wastewater treatment plant; expansion and renovation of many existing City buildings; approval and funding for several new City facilities; and the overall enrichment of the quality of life in Farmington; and

WHEREAS, she chose not to run for re-election to her council seat in the March 6, 2018 election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON that the citizens, staff and City Council are all grateful to Gayla McCulloch for her faithful and dedicated service to the City by serving on the City Council, as mayor pro tem, as a member of the PUC and MPO and her other service to the City of Farmington from 2010 until March of 2018.


