A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, NEW MEXICO SUPPORTING THE REQUEST FOR APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THE NEW MEXICO OUTDOOR RECREATION DIVISION

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington recognizes that the outdoor recreation economy is a crucial economic development driver for the State; and


