A RESOLUTION REQUESTING A TIME EXTENSION FROM THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FOOTHILLS ENHANCEMENT PROJECT, PHASE 2, MUNICIPAL ARTERIAL PROGRAM COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT [Control No. L500301, Project No. MAP-7645(913)]


WHEREAS, the City of Farmington and the New Mexico Department of Transportation ("NMDOT") entered into a joint and coordinated effort for the Foothills Drive Enhancement Project, Phase 2; and

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington agrees to provide matching funds at a percentage equal to or above twenty-five percent (25%) in the amount of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) in accordance with the Local Government Road Fund Program with NMDOT's share being One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000) for a total project cost of Two Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$240,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington supports the project and is requesting a time extension to December 31, 2021 due to COVID19, TAPF funding requirements coordination and updates to the design.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Farmington that we respectfully request a time extension for Control No. L500301; Project No. MAP-7645(913).
