

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-1798

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FOOTHILLS DRIVE ENHANCEMENT PHASE III, MESA DEL OSO TO EAST CHEVA COURT, AND REQUESTING FUNDS FROM THE FY2022 TRANSPORTATION PROJECT FUNDS (T.P.F.) ADMINISTERED BY NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR SUCH PROJECT.

WHEREAS, New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) has solicited proposed projects for funding under the TRANSPORTATION PROJECT FUND (T.P.F.) for Fiscal Year 2022 for a local road/bridge project; and

WHEREAS, Foothills Drive is designated as a minor arterial, as shown on the City's Major Thoroughfare Plan, which carries approximately 730 vehicles per day, and provides an alternate access between residential communities located in North Foothills to NM516, as well as significant retail areas on East Main Street; and

WHEREAS, the Foothills Drive Enhancement Phase III Project, Mesa Del Oso to East Cheva Court will include new asphalt sections, multi-use trail, bike lanes, storm drain improvements, geotechnical, right-of-way acquisition, and construction management; and

WHEREAS, the Community Works Director and the City Engineer recommended the submission of an application for the Foothills Drive Enhancement Phase III Project, Mesa Del Oso to East Cheva Court for funding under the NMDOT's Transportation Project Fund (T.P.F.) for FY 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON:

SECTION 1:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does hereby approve the "Foothills Drive Enhancement Phase III Project" located on Foothills Drive between Mesa Del Oso and East Cheva Court in the City of Farmington.

SECTION 2:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does further approve the total estimated cost of the Foothills Drive Enhancement Phase III Project, Mesa Del Oso to East Cheva Court, budgeting the sum of One Million Seven Hundred Sixty One Thousand Dollars (\$1,761,000) in Federal Fiscal Year 2022 for such project. With the understanding that approximately One Million Six Hundred Seventy Two Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,672,950) shall be paid for with funds from the New Mexico Department of Transportation's Transportation Project Fund (T.P.F.) for Fiscal Year 2022 and Eighty Eight Thousand Fifty Dollars (\$88,050) will be paid for by the City of Farmington.

SECTION 3:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does further represent that funds, equipment, labor and materials representing the total cost of the proposed project will be budgeted in Federal Fiscal Year 2022 and will be available when the agreement of such project becomes effective.

SECTION 4:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does further authorize the Mayor of the City of Farmington to enter into appropriate contracts with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for construction of any, or all, of the project described in this resolution under the Transportation Project Fund (T.P.F.) of the State of New Mexico.
