**DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS**

1. Presentation regarding precinct number changes (San Juan County Clerk Debbie Holmes)

Background/Rationale:

As requested by the Council at the August 16, 2011 City Council Work Session, Ms. Holmes will explain why the precinct numbers for San Juan County have been changed.

2. College Parking Enforcement Ordinance (Jay Burnham & David Eppich, San Juan College Vice President for Student Services)

Action Requested of Council:

Direct staff to prepare an ordinance that authorizes parking enforcement on the San Juan College campus by college security personnel as authorized by newly enacted state legislation.

Background/Rationale:

San Juan College officials successfully promoted a bill which was passed and signed into law during the 2011 Legislative Session authorizing colleges and municipalities to enter into agreements whereby college security personnel could be commissioned for the limited purpose of writing parking citations on the college campus. While negotiating the terms of such an agreement, it was discovered that some amendments to the City Code are necessary in order to accommodate the commissioning of security personnel and to make it a violation of City Code to park in violation of duly adopted campus parking regulations.

Staff Recommendation:

Direct staff to prepare a draft ordinance for the Council to consider at a future meeting.

Instructions Upon Approval:

Prepare the draft ordinance.

Budgetary Impact:

None. The proposed agreement requires all costs of the City to be reimbursed by the College.
