

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-1343

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AUBURN AVENUE RESURFACING PROJECT AND ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION 2010/2011 MUNICIPAL ARTERIAL PROGRAM (M.A.P.) FOR SUCH PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) has solicited proposed projects for funding under the Municipal Arterial Program (M.A.P.) for Fiscal Year 2010/2011; and

WHEREAS, Auburn Avenue from Broadway to Murray Drive (US 64) is designated as a collector, as shown on the City's Major Thoroughfare Plan, which carries in excess of 6,100 vehicles per day and provides alternate access between Broadway and downtown Farmington, significant retail areas and south to US 64; and

WHEREAS, Auburn Avenue Resurfacing from Broadway to Murray Drive (US 64) is shown on the Farmington Metropolitan Transportation Plan, the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and both the City's CIP and ICIP; and

WHEREAS, the existing road surface is inadequate due to a recent major waterline construction project to accommodate the current average daily traffic (ADT) of 6,100 vehicles; and

WHEREAS, resurfacing of the of the road section will include driving lanes, bike lanes, turn lanes and allow for a Design Hour Volume of 580 and 2 percent heavy traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Public Works Department and the City Engineer have recommended the submission of an application for the Auburn Avenue Resurfacing from Broadway to Murray Drive (US 64) for funding under the NMDOT's Municipal Arterial Program (M.A.P.) for FY 2010/2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON:

SECTION 1:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does hereby approve the "Auburn Avenue Resurfacing Project" located on Auburn Avenue between Broadway and Murray Drive (US 64) in the City of Farmington.

SECTION 2:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does further approve the total estimated cost of the Auburn Avenue Resurfacing Project, the budgeting of the sum of One Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$190,000.00) in Fiscal Year 2010/2011 for such project upon the understanding that approximately One Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$142,500.00) shall be paid for by funds from the New Mexico Department of Transportation's Municipal Arterial Program (M.A.P.) for Fiscal Year 2010/2011 and Forty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$47,500) will be paid for by the City of Farmington.

SECTION 3:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does further represent that funds, equipment, labor and materials representing the total cost of the proposed project will be budgeted in Fiscal Year 2010/2011 and will be available when the agreement of such project becomes effective.

SECTION 4:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does further authorize the Mayor for the City of Farmington to enter into appropriate contracts with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for construction of any or all of the project described in this resolution under the Municipal Arterial Program (M.A.P.) of the Sate of New Mexico.
