

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-1348

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING GRATITUDE FOR THE SERVICE OF GEORGE F. SHARPE AS A MEMBER OF THE FARMINGTON CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, George F. Sharpe was elected in March of 2002 to serve on the Farmington City Council on behalf of Council District Three; and

WHEREAS, he was appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council in October of 2002 to serve as the Council's *ex officio* member to the City's Board of Public Utility Commissioners (PUC) and has served on the PUC since that time; and

WHEREAS, Councilor Sharpe was appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council to serve as one of the City's representatives to the Ozone Task Force Signatory Committee and has been a very active participant on that task force; and

WHEREAS, Councilor Sharpe was re-elected to the City Council in 2006; and

WHEREAS, he was also elected by the Council in 2006 and 2008 to serve as the Mayor Pro Tem, to serve temporarily as the mayor and conduct the meetings of the City Council in the absence of the elected Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Councilor Sharpe has also been very active in fund raising efforts to fund City projects, including the "Dinosaurs to Drillbits" exhibit at the Farmington Gateway Museum, construction of the outdoor basketball and volleyball courts at the Farmington Aquatic Center and Lion's Wilderness Park Frisbee Golf Course and other projects; and

WHEREAS, Councilor Sharpe used his analytical mind and engineering training to enhance the City's ability to grasp complicated technical issues, study the intricacies of the City Budget and analyze business decisions of the City's utilities, particularly the City's electric utility; and

WHEREAS, he chose not to run for re-election to his council seat in the March 2, 2010 election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON that the citizens, staff and City Council are all grateful to George F. Sharpe for his faithful and dedicated service to the City by serving on the City Council, as mayor pro tem, as a member of the PUC and his other service to the City of Farmington from 2002 until March of 2010.
