

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-1350

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AUBURN AVENUE RESURFACING PROJECT AND ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION 2009/2010 MUNICIPAL ARTERIAL PROGRAM (M.A.P.) FOR SUCH PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) awarded projects funded under the Municipal Arterial Program (M.A.P.) for Fiscal Year 2009/2010; and

WHEREAS, Auburn Avenue from Apache Street to LE Murray Drive is designated as a collector, as shown on the City's Major Thoroughfare Plan, which carries in excess of 6,100 vehicles per day, and provides alternate access between Apache Street to downtown Farmington, significant retail areas, and south to US 64; and

WHEREAS, Auburn Avenue Resurfacing from Apache Street to Piñon Street is shown on the Farmington Metropolitan Transportation Plan, the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), and both the City's CIP and ICIP; and

WHEREAS, the existing road surface is inadequate to accommodate the current average daily traffic (ADT) of 6,100 vehicles due to a major waterline construction project; and

WHEREAS, resurfacing of the of the road section will include driving lanes, bike lanes, turn lanes and allow for a Design Hour Volume of 580; and 2 percent heavy traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Public Works Department and the City Engineer recommended and received a contract for the Auburn Avenue resurfacing from Apache Street to Piñon Street funded under the NMDOT's Municipal Arterial Program (M.A.P.) for FY 2009/2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON:

SECTION 1:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does hereby approve the "Auburn Avenue Resurfacing Project" located on Auburn Avenue between Apache Street and Piñon Street in the City of Farmington.

SECTION 2:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington approved the total estimated cost of the Auburn Avenue Resurfacing Project on October 13, 2009 (Resolution No. 2009-1329) budgeting One Hundred Thirty Four Thousand Nine Hundred Four Dollars (\$134,904.00) and that NMDOT reduced the previously approved funding; and that the revised contract amount required the budgeting of the sum of One Hundred Five Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Five Dollars and Thirty Three Cents (\$105,985.33) in Fiscal Year 2009/2010 for such project upon the understanding that approximately Seventy Nine Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Nine Dollars (\$79,489.00) shall be paid for the funds from the New Mexico Department of Transportation's Municipal Arterial Program (M.A.P.) for Fiscal Year 2009/2010 and Twenty Six Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Six Dollars and Thirty Three Cents (\$26,496.33) will be paid for by the City of Farmington.

SECTION 3:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does further represent that funds, equipment, labor and materials representing the total cost of the proposed project will be budgeted in Fiscal Year 2009/2010 and will be available when the agreement of such project becomes effective.

SECTION 4:

That the City Council of the City of Farmington does further authorize the Mayor of the City of Farmington to enter into appropriate contracts with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for construction of the entire project or any part thereof described in this resolution under the Municipal Arterial Program (M.A.P.) of the State of New Mexico.
