

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-1354

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN OFFICIAL PRELIMINARY BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, NEW MEXICO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2011 AND REQUESTING STATE APPROVAL

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Farmington, a municipal corporation and political subdivision formed and existing under the laws of the State of New Mexico, has developed a preliminary budget for Fiscal Year 2011; and

WHEREAS, said budget was developed on the basis of need, with cooperation from all user departments and elected officials, and with public input provided at two separate budget meetings; and

WHEREAS, the official meetings for the review of said documents were duly published and held in compliance with the State Open Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, it is the majority opinion of the City Council of the City of Farmington that the proposed preliminary budget containing an estimated beginning cash balance of \$84,895,000 with a total revenue projection of \$185,697,028, transfers of \$9,107,362, a total expenditure projection of \$208,059,290 and an ending cash balance of \$62,532,738 meets the budgetary requirements as preliminarily determined for Fiscal Year 2011; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit this budget to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration for review and approval by June 1, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the City of Farmington, State of New Mexico, hereby adopts the FY11 Preliminary Budget herein above described and requests approval from the Local Government Division of the Department of Finance and Administration.
