A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE "NEW MEXICO MAINSTREET PROGRAM"
(NMMS)

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington is a recipient of support from the "New Mexico MainStreet Program" (NMMS) provided by its partnership with the National Trust Main Street Center through the New Mexico Economic Development Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington has entered into a two year agreement from September 2009-2011 called the Biennial Memorandum of Understanding with the New Mexico MainStreet Program and the Economic Development Division to receive support and assistance to revitalize and manage its MainStreet District to meet cultural and heritage needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington will financially support the project during the two year term of the Biennial Memorandum of Understanding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington agrees to abide by the participation requirements in the Memorandum of Understanding in order to maintain status as a New Mexico MainStreet Community in "good standing."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the City of Farmington hereby affirms and appropriates support for the "Farmington Downtown Association - a New Mexico MainStreet Project" under the Biennial Memorandum of understanding for the term of September 2009-2011 and to abide by the participation requirements in maintaining status as a New Mexico MainStreet Community in "good standing."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to sign the Memorandum of Understanding with New Mexico MainStreet on the City's behalf.
