

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-1367

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDS PURSUANT TO THE NEW MEXICO FOREST RE-LEAF FUNDING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington recognizes the need for shade trees within the boundaries of Farmington; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Forest Re-Leaf Funding Program provides, through the New Mexico State Forestry Department, Forestry Division for allocation of public funds in the form of grants for the purpose of enhancing the Farmington Family Sports Complex; and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed and considered the regulations and application covering administration and use of said funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON:

That the City endorses and supports such a program for shade trees as is indicated within the attached application form; and

That the City authorizes the City manager to plan, budget, and apply for a grant which, if approved, will be used to fund said program; and

That the City requests the New Mexico Forest Re-Leaf Funding Program to consider and approve said application and program, said program being in accord with the regulations governing use and expenditure of said funds.
