

Major Thoroughfare Plan QUESTIONNAIRE

The Major Thoroughfare Plan (MTP) is a map that shows general alignments and street corridors for existing and proposed major roadways. The MTP is a guide for transportation development and right-of-way acquisition. The map is a graphic representation that addresses transportation improvement needs over a 20-year planning period and should be updated regularly (at least every 5 years or sooner) to accommodate changing development trends.

The purpose of this meeting is to review the proposed changes to the current MTP. The proposed MTP should address well-functioning traffic circulation and connectivity to roadways within the city, as well as those outside the city limits; to assure that the city has a well-functioning roadway system.

Please review the current MTP, the map of proposed growth development, the map of vacant land and answer the following questions about the proposed MTP:
