

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-1730

AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN CAPITAL OUTLAY PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY
NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington and the New Mexico Department of Transportation enter into a Cooperative Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$1,084,000.00 to be funded by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 100% or \$1,084,000.00; and
- b. City of Farmington's proportional matching share shall be 0% or \$0.00.

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington shall pay all costs which exceed the total amount of \$1,084,000.00.


Now therefore, be it resolved in official session that the City of Farmington determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

That the project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on June 30, 2023 (for Laws of 2019) and the City of Farmington incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

The City of Farmington enters into Cooperative Agreement Control Number (CN-C5193389) with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for Capital Outlay Laws of 2019 to acquire land and archaeological and environmental clearances for and to plan, design and construct the Villa View flood control detention facility within the control of the City of Farmington in Farmington, New Mexico.


